# Rail Excursion Series Being Offered

GOWANDA — The New York and Lake Erie Railroad has announced it will be offering a series of rail excursions this fall.

Excursions depart from the depot either Saturday or Sunday and are

destined for various points on the line. No reservations are needed for Sunday excursions, but they are required for Saturday trips.

The Autumn Leaves Express is a Saturday trip which leaves Saturday Oct. 11 and 25 at 10:30 a.m. Fares are \$15 for adults, \$8 for children 3 to 11 and children under 3 are free.

The Railfan's Holiday, a 90-mile excursion which covers the entire rail line, departs 9:30 a.m. Oct. 18. Fares are \$20 for adults, \$13 for children, under 3, free.

The Spooks and Goblins Halloween Special will leave Gowanda at 1 and 3:30 p.m. on Oct. 26. It will depart from South Dayton at 2:25 p.m. Fares are \$6 for adults and \$4 for children, and free for children under age 3.

The Senior Express departs from Gowanda at 1:30 p.m. on Oct. 7, 16 and 21. Fares are \$5 for seniors, \$7 for adults, \$4 for children and free for children under 3 free.
