

WEATHER HINDERS PLANE SALVAGING

Weather hindered a Navy salvage crew Monday attempting to bring a Skyraider attack bomber to dry land near Dewittville. It still lies under the surface in about 20 feet of water.

The plane, now located about 1,000 yards off shore, went down in about 60 feet of water off Point Chautauqua last Tuesday noon. The pilot, Lt. (jg) Barry F. Hampe, 20, on a flying tour out of Oceana, Va., Naval Air Station, escaped unhurt. Salvage operations were expected to be continued today if weather permits.
