

RTPI To Host Author For Book Signing

The Roger Tory Peterson Institute, 331 Curtis St., will host author Norman E. Wolfe from 1 to 3 p.m. Saturday for a program and book signing.

Wolfe, author of *Birding in Central and Western New York*, has been a bird lover most of his life. He lives in the Rochester area, where he has been active in birding and the natural world.

With the knowledge that birdwatching is one of America's favorite activities, he has created a guide showing when, where and how to find birds that migrate through Central and Western New York. Included in his book are maps and directions for travel on foot, by canoe or

kayak, by bicycle and even a few where you don't have to leave your car.

This guide explains simple keys to bird identification along with the history of bird development and how it affects where you're likely to find them today. It shows how to have fun outdoors with minimal environmental impact. Central and Western New York are prime birdwatching areas.
