It takes almost a full year between the time designer Bruce Bradshaw conceives an idea for a piece of furniture to the time it's ready for market.

One of his newest designs has a patent pending, Combs says. It's the entertainment center, 35-by-22-by-29 inches. The front tips up and slides beneath the top and a pull-out platform glides out from the bottom so

that a hidden television set can be brought forward and swiveled to face several directions.

Bradshaw has given other Jamestown Lounge furniture these distinctive features: the wall units have leveling legs, the credenza and oval coffee table concealed casters.

These and other touches, including dust panels beneath drawers and plywood back panels screwed into place, are further evidences of the quality, says Combs.
