

# Dahlstrom's Talk Resumed, Maddox Raised

Negotiators attempting to end the 122-day-old strike at the Dahlstrom Metallic Door Company were scheduled to gather around a conference table at 2:30 P.M. today in Hotel Jamestown.

The meeting will be the fourth since negotiations were resumed last Tuesday and the first since Thursday afternoon.

Elsewhere on the city's labor front, about 180 employees of the Maddox Table Company ratified a pay raise ranging from six to ten cents and retroactive to Oct. 1.

Santino R. Ciechlni, president of the Maddox Workers Independent Union, said the wage increases were the result of about two months of negotiations under a wage reopener in the union's contract. The increases, he said, are subject to approval by the Wage Stabilization Board.
