

Two-Year Contract Signed by Maddox Union, Company

A new two-year contract, including a 10-cent package wage increase and improved life insurance and other fringe benefits, has been signed by Maddox Workers Union (Ind.) and Maddox Table Company.

The new contract, which goes into effect on Monday, follows several weeks of talks between company and union officials.

William Shearman, Frank E. Shearman III, Jesse Robbins and Harold Murray represented the company, while the union was represented by Santino Cicchini, president; Willard Round, vice president; Lorrain Anderson, secretary; Joseph Sena, treasurer; Walter Reed, Angelo Sena, Robert Moore, Simon Deppas, John Knapp, and Carl Carone, committeemen at large, and Arthur Ackerman, alternate.

Union spokesmen called the contract "one of the most workable and progressive ever made between the company and the union."
