

Maddox Table, Union Sign Improved Two Year Contract

A two-year contract which includes improved employe insurance benefits has been ratified by Local 44, United Furniture Workers

of America and Maddox Table Company.

The former contract was due to expire May 1, and the new contract is dated from May 1 to the same date in 1963. Wage revisions were not included in the new contract, according to the company.

Representing the union in negotiations with the company were Santino Cicchini, president; Howard Proudman, business agent; Howard Hendrickson, Anthony Constantino, John Moore, Norman Cady, Charles DeMarco, Norman Ingerson, Clifford Sparling, John Knupp, Carl Carone and Charles Borton.

The company was represented by Gerald Anderson, general manager; Richard Fischer and John Sandberg.

Mr. Borton, union treasurer, said both his group and the company "are well satisfied with the agreement which was made four weeks before expiration of the old contract."
